Driving Directions:

Begin at ICS Garage off Rt 22N.
From Cross County Pkwy, Take Sprain Brook Pkwy North
Exit **LEFT** to Tappan Zee Bridge / **I-287 West / I-87 North**
Continue on I-87 North to **Exit #16 / Rt 17 West** (Woodbury Commons)
Continue on Route 17 West to **Exit #104 to Route 17B** (Monticello Raceway)
Continue on Rt 17B (go past traffic light in town of White Lake)
Turn **LEFT on State Route 55 West**
Turn **RIGHT on Crystal Lake Rd (Country Rd-26)** go to dead end
Turn **RIGHT on CR-23 / Lumberland /Mt. Hope Rd.**
Turn **LEFT on Brook Rd** (dirt road) go to dead end
End at Route 97 - Landers Canoe Rental & Hotel (on Left) Check-in For Canoes
Proceed 1.0 mile South on Rt. 97 to 2nd river turnoff = TMR Landing

Other Event Notes:

- TMR Landing ==> Minisink is about 10 miles; which should take about 3.5 hours.
- Non-swimmer & Beginner Swimmers MUST paddle with trained adult.
- Inexperienced paddlers will be paired with Experienced Paddlers.
- Very Experienced Paddlers ONLY will be allowed to take kayak.
- Safety Procedures Discussed by Landers Staff; prior to launching; ALL must wear PFDs at ALL times.
- Waterproof bags needed for towels, lunches & Snacks. (double bag 2-gallon freezer bags);
- NO cell phone coverage on river; Limited coverage around TMR Camps.
- It is easy to get a headache from dehydration, so drink lots of water!
- Buddy System in effect on water and at all times.
- Patrol Method in effect at all times (for camping and cooking).
