Take Rt 22 North to Mills Rd	0.5 Miles
Take Mills Rd East to Hutchinson Parkway North entrance	1.0 Miles / 1.5 Miles
Continue North on Hutchinson Parkway to I-684 North	7.0 Miles / 8.5 Miles
Continue on I-684 North to Exit #9E to I-84 East	28.0 Miles / 36.5 Miles
Continue on I-84 East to Exit #20 to CT Rt 8 North (toward Torrington)	35.1 Miles / 71.6 Miles
Take Exit 36 for Huntingdon Ave. (toward Colonial Ave.)	0.2 Miles / 71.8 Miles
Turn RIGHT at the bottom of the ramp on to Huntingdon Ave.	0.3 Miles / 72.1 Miles
At the 2nd traffic light, Turn LEFT on Thomaston Ave. (go past CT DMV)	1.6 Miles / 73.7 Miles
Turn RIGHT on CT-262 / Spruce Brook Rd. (toward Waterbury Airport)	2.0 Miles / 75.7 Miles
Turn Right into Camp Mattatuck, Mount Tobe Rd., Plymouth, CT	0.25 Miles / 76.0 Miles
