TENT CAMPING GEAR LIST

(EVERYTHING MUST BE MARKED WITH SCOUT'S INITIALS)

Personal Gear:

Packed: **Returned:**

- ====> 2 water bottles (filled at home, at least 32 oz., Empty 1 liter soda bottles are ok)
- ====> Backpack OR Duffle Bag
- ====> Sleeping Bag and/or Bag Liner (avoid cotton linings) in waterproof stuff sack
- ====> Blanket (if do not have bag liner)
- ====> Flashlight and / or Headlight (incl 1 set of spare batteries)
- ====> Personal Toiletry Kit: toilet paper (biodegradable), toothbrush/paste, comb/brush, Purell (small), anti-bacterial wipes, washcloth/Camp soap (biodegradable), hand towel, dental floss, metal mirror (optional).
- ====> Personal First Aid Kit (Boy Scout Handbook, p. 289)
band-aids, antibacterial cream, pain reliever, moleskin, lip balm, anti-diarrhea tablets,
INSECT REPELLANT (ticks & mosquitoes, at least 30% DEET preferable), Sunscreen (+25 SPF)

Clothing: (dress in layers, "cotton is rotten") * = Wear # = Pack

- ====> * 1 long sleeved T-shirt (synthetic preferred)
- ====> * 1 pair pants (synthetic/nylon)
- ====> * 1 pair socks (wool or synthetic) & Hiking Boots waterproofed (preferably ankle high & broken in)
- ====> * 1 Polar fleece pullover or sweatshirt
- ====> * Wool Troop 353 Cap or Sport Fleece w/ Ear Warmers
- ====> * Warm Gloves or Leather Work Gloves
- ====> # 1 COMPLETE extra change of Fall seasonal clothes (REQUIRED--packed in waterproof bag, i.e., zip lock freezer bags):
 - ====> # 1 pr of underwear
 - ====> # 1 pr socks (wool or synthetic preferred)
 - ====> # 1 short sleeved T-shirts (synthetic preferred)
 - ====> # 1 long sleeved shirt or fleece pullover (synthetic preferred--for night)
 - ====> # 1 pair long pants (synthetic/nylon--sweats are NOT good for day wear; jeans ok)
- ====> # Poncho or "waterproof" raincoat W/ HOOD (REQUIRED)
- ====> # 1 heavy Jacket or shell (that fits over your insulation layer)
- ====> # Sneakers (for evening around campsite)
- ====> # Sleepwear (long underwear)
- ====> # 1 large Towel in large zip-lock plastic bag.

Other Required Items:

- ====> Mess Kit & eating utensils (REQUIRED) - NO PAPER PLATES OR PLASTIC CUPS ALLOWED
- ====> Compass & Whistle
- ====> Boy Scout Handbook, Pen & Small Notepad (REQUIRED)
- ====> Scout Knife (no sheath knives or automatic opening styles); Totin' Chip Card (REQUIRED)
- ====> 2-Large Trash Bags (REQUIRED).

Other Misc. / Optional:

- ====> Tent & Ground Cloth (or can use Troop Tent - let your Patrol Leader know!)
- ====> Sleeping Pad and / or Small Pillow
- ====> Duct Tape, Matches (waterproof), small sponge or broom (to clean tent)
- ====> Spending Money (\$15 - \$20 recommended)
- ====> Sunglasses w/strap
- ====> Camera and / or binoculars
- ====> Rope or Nylon Twine (1/4 " x 50 ft.)
- ====> Spare large zip lock freezer bags
- ====> Portable Chair w/back
- ====> 2-way radio (Ch 1, Security Code 37) or cell phone -- MUST BE 15 YEARS OLD TO CARRY.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

Aerosol Cans, Glass Containers of any type, candy, Electronic Entertainment Items (radios, TVs, cd/dvd players, IPODS), Weapons (real or toy), Firecrackers.

Weather Notes:

Weather in early-November ranges from 35 at night to 55 during the day, with +30% historic chance of some precipitation.

Webelos are NOT allowed to bring knives to Boy Scout event.
