Driving Directions: *Begin at ICS Garage off Rt 22N.*
From Cross County Pkwy, go North Sprain Brook Pkwy 9.0 Miles
Exit Left to Tappan Zee Bridge / I-287 3.4 Miles / 12.4 Miles
Continue on I-87 North 31.5 Miles / 43.9 Miles
Take Exit #16 / (Woodbury Commons) / Rt – 17 West 2.2 Miles / 46.1 Miles
Continue on Rt – 17 West 43.1 Miles / 89.2 Miles
Take Exit #104 / (Monticello Raceway) onto Rt 17B 0.2 Miles / 89.4 Miles
Continue on Rt 17B to White Lake Traffic Light 6.7 Miles / 96.1 Miles
Continue on Rt 17B past White Lake Traffic Light 0.6 Miles / 96.7 Miles
Turn LEFT on State Route 55 West 4.1 Miles / 101.4 Miles
Turn RIGHT on Crystal Lake Rd (Country Rd-26) **approx 5.0 Miles / 106.4 Miles**
Turn LEFT into TMR Headquarters - Check in with Ranger
