**Driving Directions:** *Begin at ICS Garage off Rt 22N.*  
- Winterhill Rd to Main St To Yonkers / Tuckahoe Rd @ Sprain Brook Pkwy 2.0 Miles  
- From **Sprain Brook Pkwy** @ Tuckahoe Rd, Head North 11.3 Miles / 13.3 mi  
- Continue on **Taconic State Parkway** North 1.8 miles / 15.1 mi  
- Exit Briarcliff Peekskill Pkwy / NY-100 N/ **NY-9A North** 6.2 miles / 21.3 mi  
- Continue on **US-9 North** 3.9 miles / 30.3 mi  
- Take exit to **Buchanan / Montrose** 0.2 miles / 30.5 mi  
- Turn Left on **Albany Post Rd / NY 9A** 0.3 miles / 30.8 mi  
- Take a quick right at **Albany Post Rd** 400 feet  
- Take a quick right at **Watch Hill Rd.** 2.1 miles / **32.9 mi**  
**Sportsman Club on the RIGHT**

**Event Details:** - Must arrive by 8:00am; All Scouts must go through NRA-approved Fire arm safety instruction.  
- Those scouts not shooting will be expected to begin Community Service Projects immediately.
